

### Visa

All GHS attendees require an e-visa from eligible countries to enter the Kingdom. E-visas are typically one-year, multiple entry allowing you to spend up to 90 days in the country. Please contact us if you do not have a Saudi visa.

#### Location

#### Wi-Fi

#### **Dress Code**

Business attire is expected during the Global Healthspan Summit. In keeping with local custom, modest attire is recommended for women in public. Layers are also suggested as temperatures in the evenings as well as indoors (AC) tend to be cool.

#### **Climate**

The best months to visit are between November and February when the weather is coldest. The average daily high in Riyadh is 24°C in February.

#### Currency & Exchange Rates

The Saudi Riyal is the currency in Saudi Arabia. It is abbreviated as or or SAR. Exchange centers are available at the King Khalid International Airport and throughout the city. ATMs are widely available in Riyadh, and you can withdraw both dollars and Saudi Riyals from the Airport ATM machines.

At present, the exchange rate is 1 SAR = 0.27 USD / 1 USD = 3.76 SAR. Please visit **xe.com** for daily rates.

# Exploring Riyadh &

Dining

Riyadh, Saudi Arabia's capital and main financial hub, is on a desert plateau in the country's center. Business district landmarks include the 302m-high Kingdom Centre, with a sky bridge connecting 2 towers, and 267m-high Al Faisaliah Centre, with a glass-globe summit. Riyadh is also an emergent foodie destination with a wealth of restaurants, specialty coffee bars and more to explore.

# Electronic Devices

Saudi Arabia currently provides electricity at 127/220 volts AC. British-style square three-pin plugs are used.

## Roaming

International roaming agreements exist with many carriers. Hotels will include access to a landline, but local and international calls can be much more expensive than calls placed on a cellular line. We suggest you check with your mobile carrier before traveling and purchase a roaming package via your carrier once on-ground.
