Global Healthspan Summit 2025

The Global Healthspan Summit (GHS) is run by the Hevolution Foundation. It is a Riyadh-based event and the 2025 theme of 'Architecting the Future' is aimed at shaping the future of healthspan. The Summit will bring together the brightest minds and stakeholders from science, investment, medicine, healthcare and beyond to enhance thinking and research around revolutionizing how we view aging and healthspan science.

Who is hosting GHS 2025?

The Summit is hosted by the Hevolution Foundation. Launched in 2021, Hevolution Foundation is a first of its kind global non-profit organization that provides grants and early-stage investments to incentivize independent research and entrepreneurship in the emerging field of healthspan science. Headquartered in Riyadh with a North America hub and plans to open offices in other global locations, the Foundation has developed a set of key goals and targets to support its vision and mission. Its vision is to extend healthy lifespan for the benefit of all humanity. Its mission is to drive efforts to extend healthy human lifespan and understand the processes of aging, leveraging a broad set of tools through diverse approaches.

What is the focus of GHS 2025?

The theme for 2025 is 'Architecting the Future'. This follows the 2023 theme of 'Together we Thrive'. Across the 2 days the Summit approaches this theme by looking at the following 5 pillars:

The State of the Science - Where do we stand?

Ecosystem Trends - How do we develop the ecosystem?

Radical Change - What will it take?

The Long View – Where will this lead in the future?

The Summit will be held at the Four Seasons Hotel Riyadh at Kingdom Center on 4-5 February 2025.

Who is attending GHS 2025?

GHS will host 100+ international speakers drawn from the fields of science, healthcare, medicine, policy, investment and beyond, leading to a diverse agenda. Together, they will look at new ways to expand the area of healthspan, including around increasing accessibility to therapeutics that extend healthy lifespan and attracting funding to the field of aging.
