INSTRUCTIONS: The Letter of Intent must be submitted here no later than July 15, 2024 at 5:00 p.m., EST, as a single PDF file application, not to exceed 5 MB. No late submissions will be accepted. The application file should be named as follows: family name, given name; for example, "Smith, Jane.pdf".

Letter of Intent

Letters of intent will be evaluated on the relevance and significance of the proposed research to the biology of aging and/or geroscience, relevance to Hevolution's goals and mission, innovation, and qualifications of the applicant as outlined in the https://example.com/hevolution/AFAR New Investigator Award Guidelines.

Please submit the LOI in English in the order as described below. Insert page number and applicant's name at the top of each page and use Calibri font that is not smaller than 11 pt. with at least 1/2 inch margins on all sides. Any figures and essential references must be included on page 2.

A complete Letter of Intent (no more than 7 pages total) includes:

Page 1: <u>Title Page</u> with abstract (include in space provided)

Page 2: <u>Project Description</u>, A-D **must** be addressed, following the format below:

A. Significance of this research to the field of aging biology and/or geroscience.

- B. Brief description of hypothesis
- C. List of Specific Aims
- D. Any figures and essential references (optional)

Pages 3-7: Biosketch (download template here) Up to 5 pages total. Applicants must be

independent investigators with independent research space for at least 3 years, must have at least 3 senior author publications and must be no more than 12 years beyond start of postdoctoral research training as of July 15, 2024. Be sure to include past and current funding with dollar amounts and highlight in **bold** at least three senior author

papers (corresponding author or review articles do not count towards this)

Your Dean, Department Chair (or equivalent) must complete an institutional commitment form, to be submitted separately by email to afarapplication@afar.org. Download the form here.

The Letters of Intent will be reviewed by a committee. Applicants will be notified by mid-September, 2024: a subset of applicants will be invited to submit a full application by late October, 2024.
